Help, my pet is injured!

We all consider it normal to have a minimum of first aid material at home for ourselves and/or our children (such as disinfectant spray, cream, plasters, ...).

But what do you do if your pet has an injury?

An accident is always possible, even with a (domestic) animal.

Wounds on your cat, dog, rabbit, horse, etc. can occur in different ways. The animal may have been injured accidentally, or it may have just undergone a procedure at the veterinarian.

Wound care on animals is often a bigger challenge than first aid on humans.

The Treatment

The first step in treating a wound is to clean it. You can do this by rinsing the wound thoroughly with water. Water is not harmful to the wound. While rinsing,

apply gentle pressure to the skin around the wound to flush out any deeper dirt from the wound.

You may want to remove the fur around it to prevent hair from getting caught in the wound.

For large, deep wounds, always consult your veterinarian!

For simple and superficial wounds, you can apply a cream (honey ointment, wound ointment or antibiotic ointment - no isobetadine, no black ointment) to prevent the wound from further infection.

To prevent your pet from biting the wound or getting dirt in, it is best to cover the wound. **Applying a normal plaster is simply impossible...** So what to do now?

Our range of **self-adhesive bandages** are highly efficient and particularly suitable for the care and protection of our furry friends' wounds! The entire assortment is designed to be used as easily and effictively as possible.

The bandages are all made without glue, and are self-adhesive. By this we mean that they only attach to themselves, and nothing else! This prevents the bandage from sticking to the wound or to your pet's hair. In addition, our bandages are **very light**, so your pet will hardly feel the bandage.

The first layer is applied to the wound and the second layer stabilizes the first layer and absorbs excess moisture from layer 1. Then the third layer provides the final touch and additional protection.

Thanks to the selfadhesive nature of our bandages, you don't have to worry about tape or additional fixation.

Pet protection smartplaster with compress

A firm bandage with built-in wound pad.

The wound pad makes it very easy to use this bandage directly on the wound. The rule of the 3-layer application also holds here.

!! Some points to consider when applying a bandage:

- Do not overtighten
- Not too loose, or the dressing may slough off and not provide sufficient protection to the wound.
- Always apply the dressing counterclockwise from the bottom to the top.
 Blood flows downward (from the head to the legs) and therefore must be pumped upward.
